I am happy to report this week we have no new cases of COVID-19 in either staff or residents. I am also thrilled to announce we just completed our assisted living state survey and were found deficiency free! This is the best result we can receive from a state survey. Needless to say, it has been a wonderful week at The Village at Augsburg.

Most importantly, we are so happy we were able to reunite skilled nursing and assisted living residents with their families as we began indoor visitation. We are so thankful for everyone's cooperation in adhering to the policies we have put forth. It is so important for families to be together and we are grateful we are able to do this.

In accordance with new regulations, we are now testing team members for COVID-19 once per week. We evaluate this based on Baltimore County's positivity rate. If the positivity rate goes over ten percent, we will go back up to twice a week.

Residents continue to enjoy safe, small group, in-person activities. We continue to evaluate offering opportunities for residents to safely gather, including the addition of limited in-person dining in assisted living and skilled nursing (the independent living dining room remains open).

If you have not already, we encourage you to schedule a visit with your loved one. If you cannot visit in-person, we can still accommodate virtual visits.
