I am happy to start this week's update with the news that we have no additional cases of COVID-19 in residents or team members

As many of you may have heard, yesterday Governor Hogan released new information regarding in-person visitation for skilled nursing and assisted living, which can begin as soon as March 1, provided the community has no cases of COVID-19 in residents or team members. Each community is responsible for creating their own policies. Our team is working on these policies for Augsburg and will have them available in the coming weeks. We will ensure we can safely reunite families, with our top priority remaining keeping residents free from COVID-19. It is important to remember, we will still require all visitors to be symptom screened, wear a mask and maintain social distancing.

This week we held our last vaccination clinic. Nobody that received the vaccine had a significant adverse reaction. We encourage all families to receive the vaccine once it is made available to you. This will help us in returning to some sense of normal.
