Subject: Path Forward Community Update

This is the message you have all been waiting so patiently for. In accordance with Governor Hogan's newest COVID-19 regulations, we have been cleared to begin indoor visitation as long as all residents and team members remain negative for COVID-19.

While we are excited to welcome families back into the community, we must do so in a way that puts resident's safety first. In doing so, we will have strict policies that will need to be followed. The complete policy is attached to this email. On your first visitation, you will be asked to sign the second sheet acknowledging you have read and understand the policy.

The first day for visitation will be Wednesday, March 3 from 10 a.m. until 12:30 p.m. and again from 2 until 4:30 p.m. Starting the week of March 8, visits will occur every Monday and Wednesday from 10 a.m. until 12:30 p.m.

If for some reason you cannot come visit your loved one in person, please contact us directly (ycooper@thevillageataugsburg.org and csayers@thevillageataugsburg.org) and we will arrange for a virtual visit.

As you read through the policy, please remember that we have to do this in a way that prioritizes the resident's safety, but also allows us to offer one visit to every resident every week, and still allows our team to fulfill their other responsibilities through the community. We expect we will make adjustments to this as we learn what works best. We appreciate your patience and cooperation.

We hope you are as excited as we are. This is another positive step in the right direction in our fight against COVID-19. If we all prioritize caring for one another and keeping COVID-19 out of the community, we are hopeful we can gradually move to a less stringent visitation policy.
