I would like to start this message out announcing that I have made the bittersweet decision to resign my position as Healthcare Administrator at The Village at Augsburg. I will continue in the role until March 18. This was a difficult decision for me. I love Augsburg, the residents and our team. However, I felt called to accept a new role. I am thankful that as this career move came my way, I am able to depart knowing Augsburg is in wonderful and capable hands with our Executive Director, Rusty Mitchell and Director of Nursing, Yetunde Johnson. The search has already begun for a new Healthcare Administrator. It has been my pleasure to serve the residents and families here.

I am so excited to announce the Health Department has cleared us of outbreak status and we can begin to resume limited in-person services. Possibly most exciting is preparing to reopen our salon. Starting out, we are going to limit services and will not be offering perms or color. We are hopeful we can offer those services after everyone has a chance to receive the basics. Included in this email is a price list for these services. We have also included a consent form, which each resident will need before receiving services.

Since the manner of salon services does not allow for social distancing between the stylist and client, rest assured everyone will be masked appropriately and the stylist will be included in community testing for COVID-19. We will also limit the number of clients in the salon at one time so residents can socially distance safely from each other.

We continue to work on our visitation policy and expect to have this available later this week in time for Governor Hogan's target date of March 1 for allowing visitation.
