This week we learned a skilled nursing resident and two team members have tested positive for COVID-19. The resident was moved to the COVID-19 neighborhood as soon as we received the results and the family was notified. We are performing contact tracing and will continue to test all skilled nursing residents and team members weekly until we have two weeks without positive test results.

Our team continues to utilize appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE) and follow all guidance around infection control including regularly washing hands, maintaining social distancing and disinfecting surfaces.

On Monday, we held our second vaccination clinic in partnership with Walgreens. I am happy to report most residents consented to the vaccine. While this is a step in the right direction, we have not received any guidance from the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) on when we can begin to allow visitors inside the building. We are looking forward to this, and will let you know as soon as they release any updated regulations. We do encourage that when the vaccine is made available to you, you make the choice to get it, which will help immensely in a return to normal.
