Late yesterday we learned a contracted team member tested positive for COVID-19. This individual had direct contact with 13 residents in the skilled nursing neighborhood. Those individuals have been moved to the observation neighborhood on a 14-day quarantine. We are happy to say, nobody is showing symptoms and the team member is doing well. If your loved one has been affected, their Power of Attorney has been notified with a phone call.

Unfortunately, according to the Maryland Department of Health's regulations, this puts us back in outbreak status and we will have to limit visitation to virtual visits and glass door visits. Individuals on the quarantine neighborhood can only receive virtual visits. We know this is frustrating, however, realistically, this is the pattern we are seeing with National Lutheran's other communities, as well as other providers throughout the country as COVID-19 cases continue to spike across the nation.

If we do not have any more positive cases in residents or team members over the next two weeks, we will move back to reopening and are prepared to immediately offer indoor visitation in the event we have to shut down again shortly after.

Our team members continue to utilize appropriate personal protective equipment to protect themselves and residents from COVID-19.
