Subject: Augsburg Path Forward Update

It goes without saying 2020 has been an unprecedented and unpredictable year for everyone. As we continue into fall and start preparing for the holidays, we have received many questions about independent living residents traveling, as well as having guests in our community.

Unfortunately, we do not have a straightforward answer, but are able to provide tools to guide residents and their families in making decisions about quarantines when a resident returns from vacation, or requiring an out-of-town relative to quarantine before visiting our community.

To summarize, any resident who travels internationally or domestically by airplane, bus, rail or water, **must** quarantine for 14 days. The same is true for guests arriving to our community. If a resident travels by car (or a guest arrives by car) they will only have to quarantine for two weeks if they are arriving from a region with a positivity rate of over 10% (based on Center for Medicare and Medicaid Services guide at the time of the trip). We have attached a sheet with instructions on how to access this information.

It is also important to note that as COVID-19 cases are rising across the country, we may have to alter this process prior to the holidays, but will make every effort to accommodate residents and their families.

Our number one priority is and will always be the health and safety of residents. We know traveling and visits to and from family is an essential part of mental wellbeing. We want these visits to happen, but need everyone to act responsibly so we can keep COVID-19 out of our independent living neighborhood.
