Subject: Path Forward Community Update

This morning a team member was tested for COVID-19 using a rapid test after exhibiting a fever during screening. Unfortunately, the team member tested positive for COVID-19. We have performed a lab test to confirm the results. We have also learned a contractor who provides services in our community has also tested positive.

Due to these results, both assisted living and skilled nursing are in outbreak status. We are temporarily pausing communal dining and group activities. All residents and team members will be tested for the virus once a week for the next two weeks. If all test results come back negative, we can resume in-person dining and activities.

We know this is a disappointing set back, however, with ease of restrictions across the state, we expected cases to rise. This serves as an important reminder for everyone to continue to wear masks, wash your hands regularly and practice social distancing. Our leadership team is working diligently to ensure team members are following all infection control best practices.
