Subject: Path Forward Community Update

Yesterday we received test results for residents in assisted living and skilled nursing. Unfortunately, one resident in skilled nursing tested positive for the virus. This resident is asymptomatic, has been temporarily moved to the COVID-19 neighborhood and we have talked with their family.

Through contact tracing, we do not believe the resident contracted the virus in the community. They did not have contact with the team members who tested positive for the virus earlier in the week. It is likely the virus was contracted at an outside appointment.

Over the next two weeks, we will continue to test all residents in assisted living and skilled nursing. We will also be testing team members twice a week. Our team continues to utilize appropriate personal protective equipment including masks, goggles and gloves.

As we continue to battle the pandemic, we remind everyone the best thing to do to assist us in keeping your loved ones healthy is to continue to wear masks, social distance from those who live outside your household and wash your hands regularly.

Despite these most recent challenges, we are committed to making Mother's Day special for residents and their families. Our plans may have to be altered depending on COVID-19 test results, so we ask everyone remain patient and flexible. We will announce more as we get closer to that weekend.
