This morning I learned that a team member who works in our assisted living neighborhood has tested positive for COVID-19. This team member is under quarantine until cleared by the health department and is doing well.

As you know, one positive test means that our neighborhood is in outbreak status. This triggers a few different things:

- We are pausing all in-room visitation in our assisted living neighborhood immediately for at least 14 days.
- We will be able to coordinate window and porch visits. If you would like to schedule a window or porch visit with your loved one, contact Phyllis Jackson from our ConnectedLiving team at pbeltjackson@thevillageataugsburg.org or at 410-486-4573 ex. 164.
- We will conduct at least two rounds of COVID-19 tests. If we have two weeks of negative tests, we will be able to lift outbreak status.
- All team members immediately switched to KN95 masks rather than surgical masks.
- In conversation with the health department, they are allowing us to maintain group activities as well as communal dining since all residents are vaccinated.
- We will continue to monitor all residents for any symptoms of COVID-19.
