Subject: Path Forward Community Update

We are starting the week with great news. The Village at Augsburg assisted living is officially out of outbreak status!

We can immediately resume unscheduled, in-person visitation for all assisted living residents (guests will still be required to follow all of Augsburg's COVID safety measures). We are also going to reopen our salon.

For families of skilled nursing residents, this change means you can return to the normal traffic pattern, using the front entrance near the concierge desk when you arrive to visit your loved one.

Last week we announced that Augsburg and National Lutheran Communities & Services (NLCS) have made the decision to mandate the vaccine. Team members have until October 31 to complete the vaccine series. Between now and then, we are requiring unvaccinated team members to be tested twice a week for the virus.
