Today we learned a team member who works with SNF and assisted living residents has tested positive for COVID-19. This individual has not worked in the community since last Friday and has a role that does not require direct contact with residents. The Baltimore County Health Department is requiring us to perform two rounds of tests on all residents and team members. When those test results are back, if they are all negative for the virus, we will be able to lift the outbreak. We will send a communication next week to let you know results before going into the second round of testing.

The biggest impact this has is that we must immediately suspend in-person visitation. Residents are able to continue to engage with in-person activities and dining. We can also accommodate virtual visits.
