Subject: Path Forward Community Update

As you all know, last week a member of our team tested positive for COVID-19. By the Health Department's standards, this constituted an outbreak and as a result, we tested all team members and residents. We have received results back and have no additional cases of COVID-19 in either team members or residents. The Department of Health is allowing us to open visitation again.

As a reminder, please follow the below guidelines when visiting to continue to ensure the safety of residents and team members.

- When you arrive for visitation, you will be asked to complete a screening questionnaire and have your temperature checked. If the concierge has any concerns regarding answers or your temperature is above 99 degrees, you will be asked to return a different day.
- Masks are required throughout the building for all guests, regardless of vaccination status. Once you have arrived in your loved ones room, if you are vaccinated **and** your loved one is vaccinated, you may remove your mask. When you leave your loved ones room, you must put your mask on again. If you do not have a mask with you, the concierge will provide you with one.
- After you are finished at the front desk, please proceed directly to your loved ones room.
- Please remain at least six feet from our team members, other guests and other residents.
- Please utilize the hand sanitizer stations throughout the building.
- Most importantly, if you are feeling even the least bit under the weather, do not visit until you are feeling well.

We have rescheduled our COVID-19 booster clinic for November 23. As a reminder, residents are eligible for a booster if it has been six months or more since they received either the second dose of Pfizer or Moderna, or more than two months after receiving the one-dose Johnson & Johnson vaccine. We are going to try to have more clinics available if your loved one is not eligible yet. We can also assist in providing transportation to local doctors' offices or pharmacies for those not eligible at the time of this clinic. If you are interested in having your loved one receive the booster, please contact the below individuals.
