We completed testing for all skilled nursing residents on Wednesday, December 29, and no residents tested positive for the virus. We are celebrating these negative test results!

In completing our twice-weekly team member COVID-19 testing on Thursday, December 30, we did have nine additional team members test positive for the virus. Many team members who have cleared their quarantine period have returned to work. Others will return in the coming days.

As a community, we are committed to following our infection control protocols, including properly wearing masks, hand hygiene and social distancing. These are practices that we developed nearly two years ago, and our team continues to follow them closely.
