Subject: Path Forward Community Update

We are excited to announce that The Village at Augsburg has gone two weeks without any resident or team member testing positive for COVID-19. This clears us from outbreak status. During the height of the omicron surge, through our mitigation efforts, we were able to keep all residents free from COVID. This is a significant feat, and we are so proud of the work our team members did to keep residents safe. We will continue to test team members once a week.

Now that the outbreak has cleared, we are able to adjust visitation requirements:

- Visitors no longer need to be tested or produce a negative test result before visiting
- You no longer have to use the ambulance entrance and can once again use the front entrance

With lifting those requirements, we are still keeping most of our safety protocols in place including:

- All visitors must be screened upon entrance to the community
- Masks must be worn in all common areas of the building but can be removed once you are in your loved ones residence
- Visitors are required to keep visits in their loved ones residence rather than in common areas of the building
- **Please do not visit if you are feeling at all unwell, even if you do not suspect COVID**
