Subject: Path Forward Update

We are happy to announce that The Village at Augsburg is officially out of outbreak status. For the time being, we will only be testing individuals who are symptomatic or those were granted an exception to our vaccine mandate.

As of today, the state positivity rate is at 1.43% and most mask mandates have been dropped. This is an important time to remind everyone that as a health care organization caring for the individuals most vulnerable to the virus, we have not dropped mask mandates for team members or guests to our community. Residents are not required to wear masks. Vaccinated guests are permitted to remove masks once you have arrived in your loved one's apartment or room. We are still restricting visitation to the resident's apartment or room and guest are not permitted to linger in common areas or join in activities or dining. As always, we ask if you are feeling unwell, even if you do not suspect COVID, please arrange to visit at a different time.

We will be holding a vaccine clinic on March 22 for residents and team members who have yet to receive a booster vaccine.
