Subject: Path Forward Update

Today we learned two individuals in our community have tested positive for COVID-19. Our skilled nursing and assisted living neighborhoods are now in outbreak status.

The team member in assisted living has direct contact with residents. After consulting with the Department of Health, out of an abundance of caution, we will be testing all assisted living for the virus tomorrow. This team member has been masked and following all infection control measures while in the community, which lowers the risk of transmission.

The team member in skilled nursing does not have direct contact with residents. We will be testing other team members who had direct contact with this individual.

As a reminder, we are able to continue visitation during outbreaks. We ask you remain vigilant in all infection control safety measures when you are in our community, including wearing a mask, washing your hands (or using hand sanitizer) and social distancing.

As COVID case numbers have started to increase in our area, this is not unexpected. We are confident our safety measures will help keep outbreaks isolated and only result in a limited number of cases.
