Last night we learned a team member who works in assisted living has tested positive for COVID-19. We immediately tested all residents in assisted living and have had all negative results. We are in the process of testing additional team members who have had contact with this individual.

As a reminder, our team members are required to adhere to strict infection control practices while they are in the community, including masking and utilizing appropriate personal protective equipment, regularly sanitizing their hands and social distancing as much as possible, which significantly lowers risk of transmission.

As restrictions around the country have lifted, we ask each of you to remember the vulnerability of the population that we serve and the significantly more stringent standards we are held to under state and federal regulations. As much as we would all like to get rid of masks and live life normally, unfortunately, we are not there yet. Aside from masking, most importantly, if you are feeling at all unwell, please plan to visit at another time, even if you do not suspect COVID. We ask each of you to remain vigilant while in our community visiting your loved ones.
